

## End of Life property pouches – message from The Rev'd Katie McClure, Chaplaincy Team

### Appeal to those who can sew

When a patient dies, the Trust would like to return their more precious items (e.g. rings, necklaces, watches and phones) in a small fabric pouch which marks them out as special and protects them as they are placed into the wider Property Envelope. Would you be able to make a few along the following lines?

- The pouches can be different sizes, shapes and colours according to the items left and the age & gender of the patient.
- Sizes might be anything between 10 to 18cm (4" to 7") and can be square or rectangular (e.g. 4"x 4" or 4"x 6" or 6" x 7" etc.)
- The pouches need to be able to be closed, e.g. by a drawstring or poppers or Velcro.
- Offerings will be gratefully received by each chaplaincy department (or via Sarah / Emma if that's easier).
- If you can't sew, but have some suitable fabric, donations would also be welcome.
