SUBSCRIPTION FOR 2021

There will not be a Families First magazine separately any longer. A bi-yearly magazine will be included in the subscription and all will receive this by post from Mary Sumner House. It is therefore essential that your membership records are kept right up to date. Please inform the office IN WRITING (by email or by post) of any change.

Ordinary Branch member £31.50 (made up of MSH £20: Diocese £9.50: Roundabout £2) Indoor Members £23.50 (made up of MSH £20: Diocese £1.50: Roundabout £2) E36.50 (made up of MSH £20: Diocese £14.50: Roundabout £2)

Your Trustees decided that there would not be any increase in Diocesan or Roundabout contribution for this year. Of course, those of you who have been taking the Families First Magazine will not be paying as much!

When Trustees were made aware of this increase one Trustee sent a really lovely statement which I would like to quote here.

"I see these subs like Parish Share. We can either see PS as a 'tax' on Church attendance, paying as it does for the Vicar's stipend, etc., or we can see it as 'Growing God's Kingdom'. I see the subs in exactly the same way, we are not a club whose members have to pay for what we offer, but an opportunity to help Grow God's Kingdom under the umbrella of the MU with particular reference to families in crisis to help their understanding that they are all loved by Christ and that He is with them in their difficulties. To me, £30+ a year for members seems to be extremely good value for money. We can spend that and more having a Cut and Blow-dry or a shampoo and set; a meal for two at a local cafe can cost that amount. It's not even 60p a week. All our meetings are open to everyone (whether members or not); we do not exclude anyone, but realistically we have to live in the real world and pay our way. I like the new configuration of FWW, etc., as it will ensure that everyone has prayer material close at hand which is our central focus."

I leave you to ponder..

In a society where people are inclined to say "what's in it for me?" I find this approach so refreshing.

Diocesan Secretary – We feel that, at this time, we cannot really support a secretary as there really is not a lot to do so a number of us will be keeping the small amount of office business going until such time as we can recommence activities.

OCTOBER COUNCIL; - Again due to the current situation it is obvious that we will not be able to have our Council Meeting as arranged.
